



## IMPORTANT HEALTH COVERAGE TAX DOCUMENTS

### Information about Tax Year 2023 Form 1095-B

**Posted February 5, 2024 –**

Tax Form 1095-B shows the months you had minimum essential coverage through New Hampshire Medicaid. Due to the individual shared responsibility penalty remaining at zero for tax year 2023, the IRS no longer requires individuals to file a Tax Form 1095-B with their federal taxes.

For tax year 2023, the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services will not send individuals a 1095-B.

All Medicaid beneficiaries who had at least one day of Medicaid coverage in 2023 may request a copy of their Tax Form 1095-B from the Department of Health and Human Services.

**When requesting a Tax Form 1095-B you will be required to provide personal information such as:**

1. MID Number
2. Social Security Number
3. Date of Birth
4. Current Address

If you request a copy of your 1095-B with the required information, the Department will furnish you with a 2023 Tax Form 1095-B within 30 days of the date the request is received.
