The balance in the fund at this time, including interest is **\$40,583.35**.

The City of Nashua received a 6.57% share of the Opioid Abatement Trust Fund Distribution in the amount of \$27,223.40 on June 30, 2021. According to RSA 126-A:84, we are required to provide a report to NH DHHS on how we spent these funds on or before September 1, 2021.
