Upon receipt of these funds, the City has placed them in a separate non-lapsing fund to assist with accounting and distribution of all proceeds received from settlements and judgements.

During Fiscal Year 2023 the City of Dover has expended \$392.45 for the following purposes: \$200.00 To support opioid mobile intervention, treatment, and recovery services offered by qualified professionals.

\$192.45 To provide transportation services to opioid treatment and/or recovery programs/services.

As of June 30, 2023 the unexpended balance of Opioid Litigation Settlement funds is \$161,084.33.
