

ADDENDUM #1

RFP-2022-DPHS-02-NEWBO
Newborn Screening Laboratory Services

On September 1, 2021, the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services published a Request for Proposals, soliciting proposals from a Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments (CLIA) Laboratory for the provision of newborn screening laboratory services for infants born in New Hampshire, to prevent the disability and untimely death of newborns from undiagnosed genetic disorders.

The Department is publishing this addendum to:

- 1. Modify and replace Section 4, Finance, Subsection 4.2, Rate Sheet, Paragraph 4.2.3, with the following:
 - 4.2.3. Proposers must use a baseline of 13,500 specimen tests per State Fiscal Year <u>and propose cost based on each individual specimen test</u>. <u>If the Proposer needs to test a newborn more than once, the Proposer must charge per test.</u>

4.2.3.1 Proposers must provide an itemized justification of all costs associated with the individual specimen test, as outlined in Appendix D - Rate Sheet.
